### **Begley Named Director of Outreach Services**

**(Lancaster, PA)** - The Community Action Program (CAP) of Lancaster County has named Regina Begley to the position of Director of Outreach Services.

In this position, she will manage the Outreach program that assists individuals and families in crisis with referrals and remediation of utility or heat shutoff, eviction or other necessities. In addition, she will continue to direct the CONTACT of Lancaster Helpline program that assists people in crisis with referrals to life-saving resources and interventions.

Begley joined the CAP of Lancaster County's Outreach staff in 2004 as a caseworker. More recently, she was named Director of the CONTACT Lancaster Helpline in September of 2010. Begley is a graduate of Immaculata University with a bachelor's degree in sociology and is currently pursuing her master's degree in social work at Millersville University. Begley is also a member of the Leadership Lancaster class of 2012.

Community leaders formed CAP of Lancaster County in 1966 to assist low and moderate-income individuals with the resources, skills, and knowledge needed to become self-sufficient. CAP of Lancaster County offers 32 programs and employs 300 people who provide services to approximately 35,000 qualified individuals throughout Lancaster County.
